It seems like only a short time ago we closed down another great season at Wood Valley Pool. But, it hasn't been a boring winter around the pool!!! Those of you who have wandered by, or played tennis know it's been a busy year.

We've made a lot of improvements to Wood Valley Swim and Racquet Club since this time last year. In fact, we've invested over \$70,000 in improvements! What's changed?

Most of you will remember the new deck added last year. We'll be adding another 15 lounges to the deck this year.



Remember the old ugly chain link fence around the pool? Gone! A new black metal fence replaced the chain link fence.

Ever concerned about your children leaving the security of the pool area to play on the basketball courts? The basketball courts can only be accessed through the pool. And it's all fenced in (new fence, remember).

A salt system replaced the old chlorine technology. The salt system is much softer and easy on your skin. And the water doesn't have a nasty chlorine odor (and neither do you when you get out).

We resurfaced the tennis courts last year too. In the process we replaced the nets, the net poles and the windscreens.
