Membership

The club has grown – We have a total of 298 paid members of which 47 are new. The break down is as follows:

Types of Membership:

- **Permanent:** Membership requires the purchase of one share of stock per family at a one-time cost of \$500. (may be paid over 3 years - \$200, \$200, \$100) If you move from the area, you can request a stock refund. Membership dues for 2008-2009 are \$465 per family.
- **Annual:** Membership dues for 2008-2009 are \$590 per family, and do not require a stock purchase.
- **Empty Nester:** Membership dues for 2008-2009 are \$335 per family. This requires you to be a stock holding member with no children under the age of 18 residing at your address.

Social Events

The Wood Valley Swim and Racquet Club is a social hub of the neighborhood offering recreational and social activities for the whole family.

The Wood Valley Swim & Racquet Club provides recreational activities for members, including tennis, swimming in season (May - September), basketball, and adult morning lap swim.
