### NEW COURT KEYS



The locks to the WVS&RC tennis courts are being replaced or have been replaced. The new keys will open both sets of tennis courts, the outside bathroom, and the basketball court. The key will be needed to open the courts, but once inside, you cannot be locked in.

The following rules govern the distribution of keys to WVS&RC members:

### WVSRC KEY RULES 8/2008

- 1) WVSRC keys provide access to the Tennis courts, Basketball court, and outside bathroom.
- 2) All WVS&RC active members may request a key. Keys may not be duplicated or transferred with stock.
- 3) Stock members may request a key without deposit. Keys must be returned when membership is terminated, stock is transferred, or stock is refunded.
- 4) Annual members are required to submit a \$50 deposit to receive a key. Keys must be returned at the expiration of the membership (no later than 3/31). Annual members renewing their membership may carry forward their initial deposit if membership is renewed on 4/1 of the current season. The deposit is forfeited if the key is not returned by the end of the season regardless of renewal status for the following season.
- 5) Lost keys are subject to a \$50 replacement fee.
