

GENERAL TENNIS RULES AND COURT RESERVATION POLICIES

General Tennis Rules

The tennis courts have a locked gate. It is the member's responsibility to see that the gate is locked after entering and leaving the courts. One court key may be requested per membership. A key deposit is required for annual members. Tennis court lights are controlled via an APP and are operational from 45 minutes before sundown to 11:00 PM.

A first-come, first-serve policy will be in effect with the following exceptions:

- Club sponsored tournaments, clinics, etc.,
- **Advanced Court Reservations for league play.**
- Reserved courts. This can be done via the on-line court reservation system woodvalleysrc.online_courtreservations.com
- Adults (18 or older) shall have priority on weekdays after 5:00 p.m., weekends, and holidays.

Courts for general member play may be reserved for up to two hours. Walk-on play is limited to one and one-half hours if there are players waiting.

Courts are to be surrendered immediately upon expiration of time for next reservation, or if players are waiting.

No profanity, unsportsmanlike conduct, or excessive noise will be allowed on the courts.

Courts are to be used for tennis only.

To protect the tennis court surface, players must wear shoes with smooth, non-marking soles.

All guests must be accompanied by a member.

Courts are restricted to one court per family if there are waiting players.

Court Reservation Rules and Policies

All courts may be reserved for up to two hours through the WVSRC on-line court reservation system: woodvalleysrc.online_courtreservations.com

See court reservation rules in the on-line reservation system.

Walk on play is permitted on courts that have not been reserved and is limited to one and one-half hours if there are waiting players.

Reservations are limited to adult members only. The existing general tennis rule with respect to court priority continues to apply.

After a 10-minute grace period, reserved courts become available to any waiting or walk on players.
